



Mentor Rules

Mentors are at camp to help. Please do what is requested of you by any member of the camp staff. If you see a problem, please report it to the camp directors ASAP.

- Expected to follow camp rules
- Help for the entire week of camp including at check in on Sunday and check out on Saturday.
- Expect all mentors to set a good example, make positive decisions, and join in with camper activities
- **NOT** allowed to get on any camper's horse, unless asked by an instructor
- Do not give out punishment
- **NOT** allowed to be on/checking their cell phones during scheduled riding lessons, learning center activities, electives, or other scheduled camp activities
- Must carry their own insurance on themselves
- Have a positive attitude
- Be helpful and not bossy
- The following is required, if you are bringing a horse to camp.
 - Health papers dated within 30 days of the camp by a licensed veterinarian.
 - Your horse/pony be up to date on the five-way, West Nile, and Rabies vaccinations.
 - A negative Coggins test for out of state horses.
 - Responsible for providing their own tack, hay, feed if needed, and bedding for their horse's stall
 - Only allowed to ride your horse after 6:00 pm each day unless you are needed for evening activities that night
 - Must carry their own insurance on their horse and their tack
- **Not** allowed to leave the fairgrounds during the day.
- Leave camp by 10 pm, if you are going home each night.
- **Not** allowed to attend any events also being held at the fairgrounds during the week of camp. i.e. Wild West Wednesday night dancing, stock car races, etc.
